Dourados (UFGD) is located in
Dourados city, state of Mato Grosso
do Sul, Brazil. Currently, the university
offers more than 40 undergraduate
courses and a great number of
postgraduate programs. With a student
body of over 10,000 people, UFGD, year
after year, has been ranked as *The Best*University in the State, according to INEPMEC, an institute from Brazilian Ministry
of Education.

A RESTAURANT

PORTUGUESE COURSES
